WHAT IS NAVIGATE?

NAVIGATE is the Churches of Christ Queensland Combined Internship Cohort, bringing together interns from churches across Queensland who are enrolled in internship programs within our movement.

The program is designed to support churches in making disciples and developing young leaders according to their gifts and callings. NAVIGATE offers interns the opportunity to network with peers, receive coaching and guidance outside of their local ministry contexts, and participate in shared internship experiences.

INTERNS

An intern is a leader, generally serving in a greater capacity than a regular volunteer. They are enrolled in an internship program with their local CofC Church, undertaking intentional formation, ministry experiences and opportunities, whilst exploring the option of future ministry and leadership either in the church or the workplace.

WHO'S INVOLVED

- + **Intern:** The participant in the cohort
- + **Church:** Responsible for the day to day running of their internship program.
- + **Mentor:** Someone who supports and challenges the intern in their personal journey.
- + **Navigate Coordinator:** A member of the CofC team who supports both the intern and the church as we do this journey together.



WHAT'S EXPECTED?

FOR A NAVIGATE COHORT TO THRIVE, IT IS ESSENTIAL THAT EVERYONE INVOLVED FULLY PARTICIPATES AND REMAINS ACTIVELY ENGAGED



THE INTERN



- Commits to the whole Navigate program
- Agrees to abide by the Code of Conduct
- Commits to serving a minimum of 8 hours per week

THE CHURCH



- Nominates a leader to facilitate the internship
- Provides the intern a schedule of a minimum of 8 hours per week
- Commits to mentoring and training the intern

THE MENTOR



- Commits to meeting quarterly with the intern
- Agrees to liaise with the Navigate coordinator as necessary

NAVIGATE



- Facilitates the internship cohort
- Communicates with churches and mentors
- Provides support and training as needed for interns and churches

NAVIGATE STREAMS

YEAR 1 TASTE + SEE

Year 1 of the NAVIGATE program is open to all interns and focuses on discernment, helping each intern experience and explore God's call on their life.

Our goal is to tailor the experience in such a way that it will work for your intern.

If, by the end of Year 1, an intern feels called to further explore ministry, they may be invited to continue into a second year.

YEAR 2 EXPLORE + EQUIP

Year 2 of the NAVIGATE program offers a deeper dive into leadership, allowing interns to explore ministry as a vocational pathway.

Our goal is to provide a well-rounded ministry experience, with increased opportunities and responsibilities in both local and broader church settings.

Year 2 is open through an application process, and interns must also be enrolled in a study program.



WHAT'S INVOLVED?

Participation in the NAVIGATE Cohort offers a rich variety of experiences, including two retreats and four Navigate Gatherings centered on leadership development, spiritual formation, and training. Interns will also attend key leadership conferences such as Amplify and the GLS Conference, and participate in camps like FUSE and Catapult.

Beyond this, interns will have the opportunity to embark on a mission trip, serve at Churches of Christ Queensland events like combined worship nights and social gatherings, and gain practical experience through billet placements. Interns will also have access to an online platform for networking and resources, further enhancing their growth and development.
